

**KEITH SARGENT SCHOLARSHIP FOR
STUDENTS WITH MOBILITY, VISUAL AND/OR HEARING DISABILITY
IOWA STATE UNIVERSITY**

The Keith Sargent Scholarship is open to any student with a mobility, visual or hearing disability who has completed 24 transfer credits or one academic year at Iowa State University and who has a cumulative grade point average of at least 2.75 on a 4.0 scale. Preference will be given to students whose disability is considered severe. The scholarship amount varies and may be renewed for an additional two years as long as a GPA of 2.75 or above is maintained. The award is administered through Student Accessibility Services.

This scholarship was established by Dr. Keith Sargent, an alumnus of ISU, in appreciation for the help he received from the ISU community. A tragic accident severely limited Dr. Sargent's once active life but he fought the odds and completed his PhD in Economics (1997). Through the process, Dr. Sargent learned that nothing was ever accomplished by giving up.
